FIQH

Actions which invalidate a fast:

- Eating or drinking
- Sexual intercourse
- Smoking or deliberately inhaling smoke
- Swallowing medicine or inserting it into the ears or nostrils
- Using an inhaler through the mouth or nostrils

Actions which do not invalidate a fast:

- Eating or drinking in forgetfulness
- Having a fit or losing consciousness
- Injections and eye drops (or kohl or Surma)
- Unintentional vomiting
- Wet dreams
- Treating cuts with medicine
- Smelling perfume (sprays must not be inhaled directly)

You are exempt from fasting if you are:

- Unwell, and a Muslim doctor thinks fasting may harm you
- Travelling (48+ miles) and fasting would be burdensome
- Breastfeeding, if fasting would be harmful to you or your baby
- Menstruating or have postnatal bleeding

Missed fasts can be made up after Ramadhan. If you cannot because of permanent ill health or extreme old age, then you must pay £4 in compensation (fidya), for each missed fast, to feed a poor / needy person.

TOOTHPASTE

It is makrooh to use toothpaste, and if swallowed, it breaks your fast.

Virtues of Fasting During the month of Shawwal

The Prophet (PBUH) said: "If anyone fasts during Ramadan, then follows it with six days in Shawwal, it will be like a perpetual fast." (Sunan Abi Dawood)

The Messenger of Allah (PBUH) said: "He who observed the fast of Ramadan and then followed it with six (fasts) of Shawwal. it would be as if he fasted perpetually." (Sahih Muslim)
